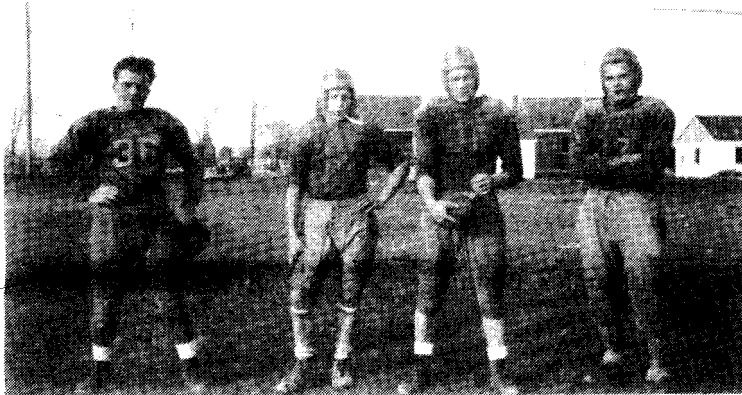

 - Assist in organizing class picture taking sessions

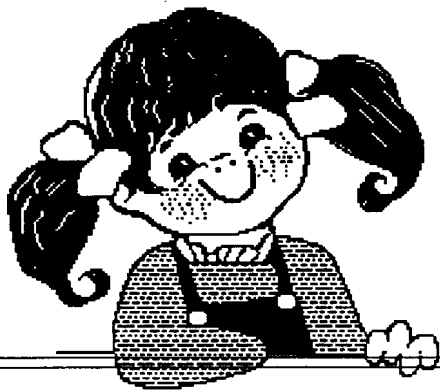
