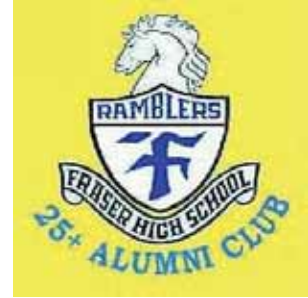

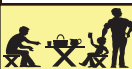

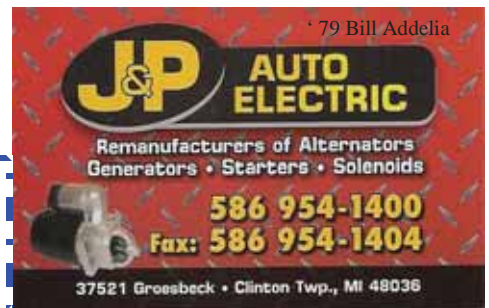

While enjoying Elsie's fried chicken and grilled marinated sirloin roasts and Rich's grilled "hot buttered corn," the group hung out at the tiki bar and reminisced while poring over yearbooks and photographs supplied by the attendees.

There were lots of laughs and "do you remember?" throughout the day. A couple of brief showers and strong wind gusts did not dampen our spirits and fun. It was a great day!!

OUR FLORIDA REUNIONS

The FHS Florida Reunion began in 1999, as the brainchild of Tom Kellar '52. He hosted it at Myakka River State Park for the first few years, with help from Linda Lahay, '65, while encouraging others to take a turn at hosting. Joanne 'Rybicki' Patrick, '59, and Linda 'Westfall' Hart, '62, hosted it at Wekiwa State Park in Apopka in 2002. Then Rich and Elsie 'Larson' Riggen accepted the challenge in 2004 and have been hosting every other year since.

One year, Tom was not able to host, so June 'Haist' Taylor, '61, and Linda Lahay hosted it in Sarasota and continue to host it on the Gulf side every other year, thus beginning the practice of alternating Florida coasts--Gulf and Atlantic.

Besides relieving one individual from the responsibility of hosting every year, the thought was that it would give more FHS alumni an opportunity to attend, depending upon their area

of residence, if it was held in different areas of Florida. Though appeals are made each year, others have not picked up the gauntlet, so June and Linda host one year in Sarasota, and Elsie and Rich host the next year in Royal Palm Beach (West Palm Beach area).

Some attendees stay overnight at hotels in Sarasota, or there are rentals at Sun 'N Fun RV Resort where the reunion is held in the resort's Cypress Room.

Some nearby attractions - Mote Marine which takes care of wounded turtles and other marine life. Sarasota is home to many cultural sites established by the wealthy Chicago Palmer House family. Mrs. Palmer (in the 1920's) brought art, opera and ballet to keep the arts planted in the area. Now the Ringling Museum of Art and Ringling Estate with circus museums, along with dinner theaters and the Van Wezel theater. The Crowley Estate, Shelby Gardens and Jungle Gardens are in Sarasota, along with the beautiful Gulf coast, drawing masses of visitors

annually. Kayaking is a favorite past time around the many mangrove tunnels, and boating in the Intercoastal Waterway is luring tourists, too. There is an Audobon Birding sanctuary less than 1/2 mile from Sun-N-Fun, called Celery Fields, with daily informative guides showing the large variety of birds in this area.

When the reunion is at the home of Rich and Elsie in Royal Palm Beach, they can accommodate a few people at their home overnight and, in addition to several hotels, there is a KOA campground at Lion Country Safari, six miles down the road.

Attractions in the area include Lion Country Safari, Palm Beach Zoo, Planetarium, Norton Museum of Art, City Place (downtown multi-level shopping and entertainment area with upscale shopping and restaurants), The Mall at Wellington Green and the Kravis Center (live theater and top name entertainment).

The Shelby resident talked about his time with the Toronto Blue Jays . . .

Q: How did your time at FHS help launch your career into the big leagues?

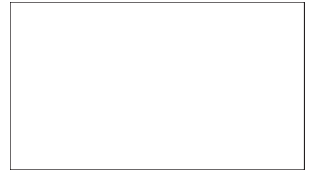
